Congratulations to all who competed.



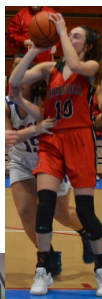
IWA Girls Basketball

IWA Boys Basketball

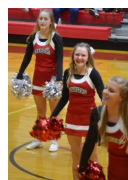

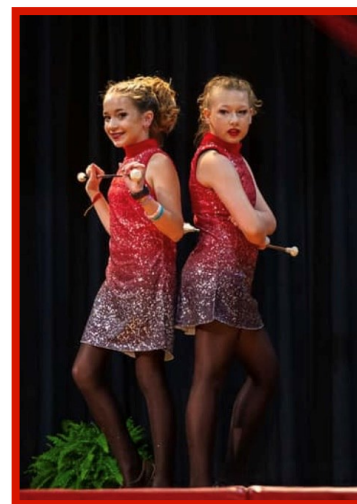


CHARGERS GOT TALENT

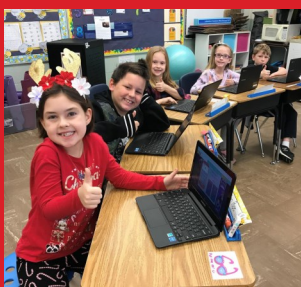
