Honors Calculus, Advanced Math, Algebra 2

- 3 – ring binder for daily notes, handouts, and homework/classwork
- Pencils for assignments
- Pens for notes, if desired
- Graphing Calculator – TI 84 Plus recommended *If you choose to purchase a different model you will be responsible for learning how to use it yourself. *Also the ones with a rechargeable battery are NOT recommended, as they do not stay charged very long and students have a tendency to come to class with them not charged.

Geometry

Algebra 1

- 3 ring binder - at least a 1 inch. You can get larger, but one inch is usually good for one 9 weeks. If your child is rough on their supplies, get several for the school year.
- Plenty of paper! We take notes daily and complete warm ups on their own paper as well. This will need to be replenished on a constant basis.
